FROM THE PASTOR:

- 1 After the Sabbath, as the first light of the new week dawned, Mary Magdalene and the other Mary came to keep vigil at the tomb.
- 2 Suddenly the earth reeled and rocked under their feet as God's angel came down from heaven, came right up to where they were standing. He rolled back the stone and then sat on it.
- 3 Shafts of lightning blazed from him. His garments shimmered snow-white.
- 4 The guards at the tomb were scared to death. They were so frightened, they couldn't move.
- 5 The angel spoke to the women: "There is nothing to fear here. I know you're looking for Jesus, the One they nailed to the cross.
- 6 He is not here. He was raised, just as he said. Come and look at the place where he was placed.
- 7 "Now, get on your way quickly and tell his disciples, 'He is risen from the dead. He is going on ahead of you to Galilee. You will see him there.' That's the message."
- 8 The women, deep in wonder and full of joy, lost no time in leaving the tomb. They ran to tell the disciples.
- 9 Then Jesus met them, stopping them in their tracks. "Good morning!" he said. They fell to their knees, embraced his feet, and worshiped him.
- 10 Jesus said, "You're holding on to me for dear life! Don't be frightened like that. Go tell my brothers that they are to go to Galilee, and that I'll meet them there."

Matthew 28:1-10, The Message

What an amazing passage! The death of Jesus, whose dead body was placed in the tomb on late Friday, was on the minds of the women. They knew he had died because they witnessed his death and they watched his body being placed in the tomb. Two women – vulnerable, weak, timid came to the tomb at the first opportunity they could go. What were they expecting to find? Or did they just want to be close to Jesus' body as they grieved, as people today often want to do when they lose a loved one?

What they did not expect was an earthquake caused by God's angel arriving *right where they were standing*. Notice what the angel says to them: "There is nothing to fear here....He is not here. He was raised...." This message wasn't intended for the disciples. It was intended for and given to the two Marys, who, unlike the guards, are not petrified to the point of fainting, but full of awe and amazement.

As they go back to tell the disciples the good news, they are met by Jesus who repeats the message for the disciples which the angel had given them. But before they obediently take off for the disciples to deliver the message, notice what they do: they fell to their knees, embraced his feet, and worshiped him. Kneeling is a response expressing awed reverence. Touching Jesus' feet was an intimate act done by people who knew Jesus well. Put the two acts together and we have the beginning of resurrection life lived out in ordinary people: awed reverence plus intimacy leads to resurrection worship.

When in your life has Jesus encountered you in such a surprising way that you knelt in awed reverence and clutched to him (most likely figuratively) in an act of resurrection worship. Because we must have a sense of "how can this be?" to fully embrace awed reverence. And we need to be in an intimate relationship with Jesus to fully trust and embrace Jesus and where he is leading us. There has to be a sense of surprise in our lives – for God does not respond, react, or encounter us in a way that we are comfortable with or that we expect and anticipate or that

we would choose for ourselves. There is always a sense of anticipation and wonderment when interacting with our Lord.

All of us around the world are dealing with an unexpected and unwelcomed unknown called COVID-19. I have been watching God interact with various people, getting their attention like no other time in their lives, building on the gift of faith that God has given each one, and molding and making them into the people God designed them to be. It hasn't been easy to have our PAUSE button pushed, to be told that for our safety and the safety of others we need to stay home and stay safe, to go from full speed ahead to STOP or PAUSE. It is sort of like watching a movie that has us mesmerized – when suddenly, at just the best part, the DVD player stops or the internet link goes down. We are left pondering how the movie will end, where will the main characters end up, will good override evil?

We have been jolted into a new reality: a reality not planned by God, not applauded by God, but that can be used by God. A reality just as surprising to us as the angel and Jesus were to the two Marys. A reality that will change the rest of our lives in unknow ways, just as the Marys' lives were changed. An opportunity to focus on what God desires for our lives, just as the Marys were given the opportunity to refocus from grieving Jesus' death to carrying a message from Jesus to the disciples.

Where is this going to lead us spiritually? I don't know. But I do know what God yearns: a deeper relationship with each one of us; an open heart to receive the Spirit; a willingness to allow God to transform us into people we never imagined we could become. What is God doing in your life right now? Pay attention. Slow down. PAUSE and reflect.
